StoryWalk® at Milton Cemetery and Arboretum

Our current story (Owl Babies) posted here is soon to be replaced. Have you ever investigated what can be seen or found over or under a pond? Visit our StoryWalk® posted around the lovely and quiet duck pond and enjoy a great children's story to see what's living and hiding at the pond!! Milton Cemetery and Arboretum is located at 211 Centre Street in Milton and is open daily from 8:00 AM to sunset. Use the side gate entrance next to the office and keep straight until you see the pond.

StoryWalk® at Houghton's Pond

Can a spider spin a web using various shapes? Find out by visiting our StoryWalk® posted on the fencing around the children's playground at Houghton's Pond! Play for a while, take a walk around the pond, bring a picnic lunch, and enjoy a great children's story, too! Houghton's Pond is located at 840 Hillside Street in Milton and is open daily, dawn to dusk.

StoryWalk® at Trailside Museum

Enjoy the story, Little Otter Learns to Swim, which will soon be replaced by a fun guessing story, Looking Closely Through the Forest. Visit our StoryWalk®, posted on the outdoor fencing of the Trailside Museum's grounds! Stroll around the outdoor grounds, visit with some animals, enjoy a snack at the picnic tables, and read a terrific children's story along the way! The outdoor grounds and exhibits at the Blue Hills Trailside Museum are free and located at 1904 Canton Avenue in Milton. They are open daily 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

What is a StoryWalk®? It's a self-guided, unique, and fun way to enjoy a children's story book outdoors. Pages of a book are laminated and posted in areas of town that are child-friendly. The pages are numbered so you don't lose your way! Story Walk® stories are typically changed every 6-8 weeks.

If you read just 1 book to your child every day, your child will have enjoyed over 1,450 books before entering kindergarten? It's a great gift to give to a child!!

Do you have a child 3 mos. to 5 years old? Check to see if they are on target for their age!

The Ages & Stages Questionnaire (ASQ), is a free, simple tool you can use to find out what your child's strengths are, and the areas where they may need more practice. The program is designed specifically for the age of your child anywhere between 3 months and 5 ½ years old, and can be done multiple times during your child's first five years of life. Simply complete a Questionnaire in the comfort of your home and submit it to us online for scoring. We'll let you know the results, help you with next steps, and provide you with fun, simple activities to help with your child's continual growth and development.
