Join Historic New England educators and staff from the Milton Early Childhood Alliance for a unique literacy event to learn about the power of wind at the Eustis Estate. Explore the beautiful landscape while reading *I Face the Wind* by Vicki Cobb. During this StoryWalk®, families try fun wind-based experiments and activities, ending at the estate's 1902 powerhouse, which originally included a wind turbine to provide electricity to the main house. Once there, you're invited to make pinwheels, then face the wind and watch them spin. Bring a picnic lunch to enjoy on the grounds, and be sure to leave time to explore the inside of the museum.

Free for Historic New England members and Milton residents. Included with admission for nonmembers. This is a drop-in program. All children must be accompanied by an adult. Recommended for ages 4–10.
